Hi, my name is Grischa I will talk about video events that we put on at my university, the University of Western Australia in Perth, on the west coast of Australia. At the moment there are only two young people here in Perth.

One is me, and the other one is Hans. Hans is musician, from Perth. Some of you have met him at Amaroo or in Europe. I am originally from Germany. I've been living in Perth for 5 years, studying Biophysics.

In total we put on 2 events at the university. Both had the same format: People were invited by handing out small invitation cards. We booked a room above the main food hall for the lunch hour, which is 1pm to 2pm here. Through my laptop we had both video and

music. The video was shown with a projector and the sound came through a small PA. We didn't provide much else - just some booklets and a list where people could put their email addresses.

For both of the events we only had several guests but we saw it as a great start and it was enough to keep our enthusiasm high.

We learned a lot though, about planning events. The things that seem most important to pay attention to were: Proper organisation and planning; Although it seems to be a simple event, it will only be successful if everything comes together properly.

Very important is the timing. Especially choosing the best time to invite people and



making the time available to invite people.

The other thing is setup time and making sure all equipment, cables, adapters are always there - rehearse the setup and run of the event. Make sure everyone is on time. Try to involve more people if possible.

Most of all, enjoy! We had great fun and I plan to do more events.
